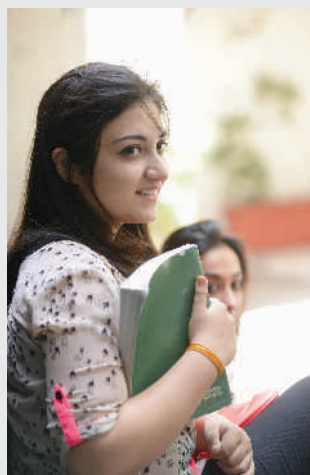

ABOUT THE WORKSHOP



Evaluation of scientific writing has become a challenge due to emergence of source of information from the digital world for the academic community. In scientific writing, the most widely recognized unethical lapse is Plagiarism. Plagiarism is the most common and most misinterpreted form of infringement in writing. It is aggravated by the easy

access to and the ease of cutting and pasting from a wide range of materials available on the internet. The cases of plagiarism of written work in academia are increasing because of lack of knowledge. There are many varieties and degrees of plagiarism. To avoid plagiarism, one must realize that what ever parts of text from previously written material of others need to be used, they should be summarized, paraphrased and structurally modified and provided with proper citation of the source. Paraphrasing from unacknowledged sources is the more frequent and hard-to-detect form of plagiarism of writing. Sometimes there is accidental plagiarism and at times those who are guilty of unintentional plagiarism tend to be unaware of proper citation and referencing techniques. That is why it is extremely important to learn the different and correct ways of citing information and to fully understand the nature of plagiarism. Its impact, consequences and techniques to avoid plagiarism will be covered in the workshop. Hence, the workshop is designed to equip the faculty and research scholars with the adequate knowledge about the facts related to ethics in scientific writing.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

Since much of plagiarism is unintentional. There is a need to make researchers understand how much

plagiarism is considered plagiarism be it related to an idea or text. The workshop will focus on the techniques of writing as so to avoid Plagiarism.

Through this workshop the participants will be able to have a better understanding on the following issues:

- Ethics in Scientific writing
- Recognition of plagiarism
- How to avoid plagiarism?
- Consequences of plagiarism

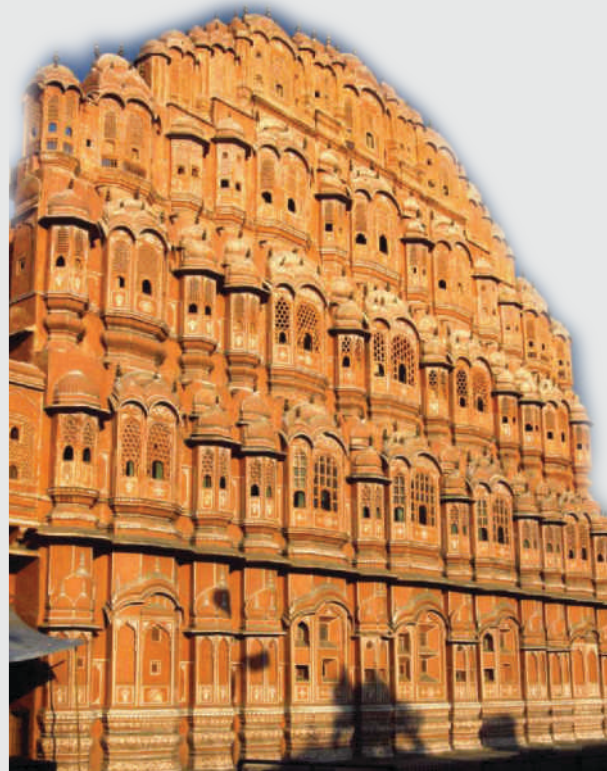
