Poster Competition on FB/Twitter: The IIS University would like to provide the opportunity to researchers to share their research, network, and engage in scientific debate through this Poster Competition to be held online on FB/Twitter. The unique formatremoves the environmental and financial costs of attending a traditional conference and helps scientific researchers share their work and network with like-minded researchers across disciplines, wherever they are in the world.

Steps:

- Create a Facebook/ Twitter account.
- Create online posters and upload them on Facebook/Twitter and tag IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur social media Facebook page/Twitter handle between 3rd January 2022 and 7th January 2020.
- The poster is to be uploaded as an image. JPEG, PNG, GIF, and must be compatible with Facebook/ Twitter. Use of Videos and/or animations are encouraged in the poster or supporting Tweets.
- Maximum image size 5 MB.
- While the recommended image dimensions are 2:1 aspect ratio for landscape, you can use standard poster dimensions (A4, A0) as much as the content required.

Judging

The online poster will be judged by a panel of experts based on the criteria based on mentioned above.

Offline Poster Competition:

Suggestions for an effective poster creation:

- Posters should stimulate discussion, not give a long presentation. Therefore, keep text to a minimum, emphasize graphics, and make sure every item included in your poster is necessary.
- Utilize handouts to supplement your poster.
- Goal: 20% text, 40% graphics, 40% space.
- Make sure ideas flow logically from one section to the next.
- Use charts and graphs to illustrate data (avoid large tables of raw data).

- Use high-resolution photographs (web images often will not work).
- Do not use all capital letters.
- The use of a typewritten, handwritten, or printed PowerPointTM presentation as a poster is unacceptable. Presentations in these formats will be removed.
- Keep consistent margins.
- Keep line spacing consistent.
- o Keep the color, style, and thickness of borders the same.
- Keep shading consistent.
- Pick no more than 2–3 fonts
- Pick no more than 2–3 colors
- Test readability
- The title banner should be legible from 20 feet away.
- Body text should be legible from 6 feet away.
